





CLEANING WHEN OVERFILLED

Don't overwork your vacuum cleaner if it's full. Remember to empty it constantly, so you never lose vacuuming power.

THINKING THAT IT'S BROKEN

If the vacuum cleaner doesn't turn on, check for anything stuck or a reset function; the fix might be that easy.






TRYING TO CLEAN UP SPILLS


You've been lucky if you've gotten away with this. Liquids ruin the motor and can cause an electric shock!

RUNNING OVER THE CORD

Let the vacuum cord out of the way!

You can peel the cable open and
make it unsafe to use.





PICKING UP SMALL OBJECTS

Avoid messing up the motor. If you see a coin or a screw lying on the floor, pick it up with your hand.
